### Kindergarten ~ Mrs. Raezer

This week in kindergarten we read the book *Five Little Ducks*. We concentrated on opposites. We reviewed beginning sounds and then worked on predicting outcomes. We also read the book *Honk! Honk! A Story of Migration*. With this story we worked on the letter "j" and practiced action words. After reading our book, we talked about wild geese and their migration patterns. We sent some other books home as well as the readers. It is important that your child reads them and returns them to us. Thank you.

In math we continued to work on the language of subtraction; such as the minus sign and reviewed the equal sign. Much of what we have done with addition and subtraction is listened to stories and manipulate objects to show the story. We then write a problem from what we have manipulated.
