School Health Policy

- I. Children may not attend classes at Grandview Heights Christian Academy when:
 - A. They exhibit outward signs of illness such as:
 1. Body Temperature exceeding 100
 2. Continuous coughing and/or sneezing
 3. Vomiting
 4. Diarrhea
 - B. They are suffering from contagious diseases such as:
 1. Acute contagious conjunctivitis (pink eye)
 2. Tonsillitis
 3. Strep Throat
 4. Ear infection with external drainage
 5. Impetigo
 6. Upper respiratory infection – URI
 7. Influenza
 8. Gastrointestinal disturbances
 9. Head Lice
 10. Body Lice
 11. Ringworm
 12. Pinworm
 13. Communicable diseases (measles, mumps, rubella and chicken pox)
- II. If symptoms of such illness occur while a student is in our care, the parent(s) will be called immediately and the student must be removed from the facility for care.
- III. Grandview Heights Christian Academy has the right through the PA Department of Education to refuse care to ill student on any given day or to request that a student be removed from the facility if the student is determined by the administration to be too ill to remain in care/classes.
- IV. For re-admission, students who have recovered from or are under treatment for any of the infectious conditions listed above must have a return to school certificate from their physician.
- V. Students must have an excuse from their parents or guardian after an illness of three days or less. Also, student must have a return to school certificate from their physician after an absence of more than three days.
